Year round programming is based out of Winter Park Resort and Sports Authority Field at Mile High.

Position Summary:

The social media/PR intern for the Wells Fargo Ski Cup will develop and execute the social media campaign specific to this event. They will actively engage and encourage event attendees to participate and promote event highlights for the 42nd Annual Wells Fargo Ski Cup. Over the event weekend, February 24-26, the intern will be responsible for posting event updates and tagging appropriate sponsors with correct social media handles, ensuring that the event campaign and hashtag is being utilized in every event post across all social media platforms. #WFSkiCup.

The internship availability is immediate - March, 2017. Applicate must be available for onsite event February 22-26, 2017 at Winter Park Resort. Lodging will be provided.

Duties:

- Develop event social media campaign for the Wells Fargo Ski Cup.
- Highlight growth opportunities in the social media field
- Actively engage event attendees and courage participation in social media campaign through tagging, sharing and liking
- Offer strategic insight and assist in implementation of social media growth opportunities
- Assist in the development of campaigns to cross multiple social media outlets.
- Research industry comparable social media presence.
- Assist with ongoing marketing projects as needed.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience Required:

- Applicants will be in pursuit or a recipient of a degree within the following: communications, advertising, marketing or other relevant field.
- A personable and outgoing willingness to approach groups of people is a plus.

- Agency or client side experience and knowledge of the social media online space is preferred including existing (Facebook, Twitter, Youtube, Instagram, etc.) as well as emerging social platforms.
- An understanding of the WordPress platform and a willingness to learn about many other types of web design tools.
- Applicants must have excellent written and oral communication skills, as well as a working knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite.
- Applicants should be well organized, self-motivated and reliable and should be able to work well both independently and as a part of a team.
