Position Overview:

The special events intern will assist with all aspects of special events, including multiple special events, fundraising functions and auction coordination. The position assists with the preparation of proposals for contributions and follow-up correspondence and acts as auction liaison when needed. Special events functions are focused on the cultivation of corporate and individual donors for the NSCD. This position allows for a flexible schedule, invaluable experience working with noteworthy corporate sponsors and fulfilling work that helps change the lives of thousands of individuals.

- Assist with marking efforts of NSCD events.
- Assist with the implementation, execution and follow up projects.
- Assist with the coordination and implementation of all other fundraising events.

- Able to concentrate and perform job duties while working under noisy, busy conditions.
- Must be able to lift and carry light loads (5-30 lbs.) for short distances (approximately two blocks).
- Dexterity, auditory and visual acuity to operate computers and phones or mobile devices.
- Auditory and visual acuity to interact with guests, sponsors, donors and clients on a daily basis.
- Able to work for long periods of time without break during the conduct of presentations and events.
- Vision sufficient or adaptive capabilities to read printed, handwritten, typed and computer generated material.
