Reinstatement Program Guidelines

The Reinstatement Program lets former members rejoin and recover their certification. The process can occur at any time during the year. The reinstatement process is for you if you are a previous member who wants to rejoin as a Certified Member or if you are an Alumni Member who want to switch to a Certified Member.

Note:

- The reinstatement process is the same for all disciplines.
- If you who want to rejoin PSIA-AASI and do not want to pursue or maintain your certification you can do so as an Alumni Member (if you meet the qualifications) or as a Registered Member and bypass the reinstatement process.
- If you are an Alumni Member and want to change your membership status to Certified Member, you must follow the reinstatement process and pay 50 percent of the reinstatement fee due.

Reinstatement Process

1 Year Membership Lapse. You must:

- Pay the previous season's membership dues (+ late fee).
- Pay the current season's membership dues.
- Continue to meet CEU requirements (6 CEUs a season).

2-4 Year Membership Lapse.* You must:

- Pay a \$200 reinstatement fee.
- Pay the current season's membership dues.
- Follow the certified inactive process and earn CEUs for each year you did not pay dues:
 - 1 year: 12 CEUs
 - 2 years: 18 CEUs
 - 3 years: 24 CEUs
 - 4 years: 24 CEUs

5 Years or More Membership Lapse.* You must:

- Pay a \$300 reinstatement fee.
- Pay the current season's membership dues.
- Follow Steps #1 - #4 below

STEP #1 all disciplines

If your membership expired prior to 6/30/2017, you must pay \$300 to cover back dues plus this year's dues, \$125. If your membership expired after June of 2017, please contact the office.

STEP # 2 all disciplines

Your current Snowsports School Director and Training Manager submit letters of recommendation for reactivation.

STEP #4 All Disciplines

Register for the reactivation assessment session. The price of this assessment is \$195.00. This half day assessment is to be completed with a divisional educator at or near your home area. Applicants must demonstrate their ability to ski/ride at or above the Level 2 standard. All former Level 3’s will be expected to ski/ride and be coached through the Level 3 tasks. Applicants who meet these requirements will be reinstated. Applicants who do not meet these requirements will be encouraged to visit the appropriate educational clinics. Applicants may then reapply for a future reactivation assessment day given that the two-season window on completion of the program has not yet expired.

***Nordic and Adaptive** must contact the office to determine STEP # 3 and #4.

*If you are going through the reinstatement process your membership card will show certified inactive status until you meet the reinstatement process requirements and return to certified active status.

*If you are more than 10 seasons without PSIA-AASI membership but have remained active coaching snowsports, please contact the RM office to discuss options for your reinstatement.

*Level 1 certifications can be reinstated. Members can join the reinstatement program and follow steps 1-3. Any combination of educational courses totaling 24CEUs will be accepted for Level 1 Reinstatement and step 4 is not required. Alternatively, former Level 1 members can join as a new member by paying the current season’s membership fees and either retake the Level 1 exam or begin the Level 2 certification process. If the latter is chosen, it’s important to note that no certification will be recognized until a certification assessment is passed.
