- 1: Essential elements were not observed or not present.
- 2: Essential elements are beginning to appear.
- 3: Essential elements appear, but not with the necessary consistency.
- 4: Essential elements appear regularly at a satisfactory level ( $\geq 75\%$  of the time).
- 5: Essential elements appear frequently, above required level ( $\geq 85\%$  of the time).
- 6: Essential elements appear continuously, at a superior level ( $\geq 95\%$  of the time).
