All PSIA-Rocky Mountain Education Staff Members are hired to work specific days throughout the year and are responsible for delivering products in a clinic or exam format as outlined by the job descriptions and the product outlines. E1 examiners will deliver exceptional customer service in a professional manner as well as uphold the National Certification standards.

Active Status Employee

Examiner/Education Staff Members maintain an active status by attending Fall Training, working a minimum of 10 days/season for the division, and employed a minimum of 30 days/season for a Rocky Mountain Member Ski School. Fall Training is mandatory for all active staff members. Employees are compensated 12 hours for attending this event. Those missing any part of the training must make up those days at the discretion of the Director of Education and their discipline committee chair.
