Level 2/3 Exam Preview Clinic

Duration: Half-Day (no CEU's are awarded)

Setting: This 3-hour 45-minute low intensity clinic is designed for candidates to preview terrain that possibly could be used for exam tasks, maneuvers, and teaching terrain with a PSIA-RM examiner

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the clinic participants will be able to:

- Identify terrain where assessment tasks may be performed
- Identify terrain where teaching progressions may be held
- Be familiar with tactics to increase confidence and decrease nervous emotions

Prerequisites:

- **Level 2:**
 - Level 1 Certified
- **Level 3:**
 - Level 2 Certified

Suggested Learning Experiences:

- Select terrain and lines likely (not guaranteed) to be selected for blended, highlighted, and applied tasks
 - Discuss general criteria and rationale for selection
 - Traffic flow, grooming, exposure, etc.
 - Allow participants to ski through tasks. Don't provide feedback on ski/body performance
- Discuss how the environment may be affected by skier traffic flow, sunlight/cloud cover and/or predicted weather changes. Discuss impact (if any) of changing conditions on candidates' speed and accuracy
- Select terrain suitable for teaching progressions
- Discuss exam outline and process

Reminder for Clinic Leader(s):

- Feedback should be given on tactics for performing well at the exam
- Feedback should not be given on participants skiing
