Managing Splits and the Family Private

Discipline: Alpine

Time: 2 Days **Credit Hours:** 12

Setting: on snow

Course Description: This 2-day clinic will focus on enhancing the Pro's ability to be successful when working with Splits and Family Privates. Participants will gain tools and creative concepts for working with Splits and Family Privates

Recommended Prerequisite Courses: Level 1, Children's Specialist 1.

Course Objectives:

- Participants will strengthen the knowledge of using the mountain as a resource for managing group dynamics. **(Cognitive)**

Sample Activities:

1. Using conversation and questioning to gain information specific to all participants.
2. Developing goal statements for individual in the group.
3. Using Nastar, Terrain Parks and natural terrain features to develop skills and group cohesion.
