## Children's Education Training Team (CETT) Education Staff Application

We are seeking dedicated children's educators who are willing to put in time and energy to help us in making Rocky Mountain children's events the best in the country. Children's Education Training Team (CETT) staff members are responsible for delivering a great educational product, and are asked to help develop and implement new educational products. This job is for the Children's Division of the Advanced Educator's group - specifically, you will be delivering children's education products. All Educational Staff Members are hired to work specific days throughout the year and are responsible to deliver products in a clinic or exam format as outlined by the job descriptions and the product outlines. They will deliver exceptional customer service in a professional manner as well as uphold the National Certification standards.

Education Staff Members maintain an active status by attending Fall Training, working a minimum of 8 days/season for the division and being employed a minimum of 30 days/season for a Rocky Mountain Member School. Fall Training is **mandatory** for all active staff members. Employees are compensated 10 hours for attending this event. Staff must attend all scheduled days of training in order to get CEU credit for attendance. Those missing any part of the training must make up those days at the discretion of their respective discipline committees.

### **Qualifications:**

- ❖ Rocky Mountain Trainer (Trainer Accredited) in respective Sports Discipline
- ❖ Children's Specialist 2 (Children's Accredited)
- ❖ Freestyle Specialist Certificate
- ❖ Additional Discipline Certification
- ❖ Five years teaching experience with children's training experience as well as a strong desire to work with children's educators.

### **Application Process:**

- Submit a letter of intent for the position of RM CETT Education Staff Employee.
- Submit a snowsports resume
- Submit three letters of recommendation. One letter must be from your School Director.
- Submit a children's specific technical/teaching article (600 – 1000 words)
- Include answers to these questions with your application packet:
  - a) What are the attributes qualifying you for the role of a CETT staff member?
  - b) What would you envision your role and responsibilities to be as a member of the children's education staff?
  - c) Due to the changes taking place in the snow sports industry today (i.e., family privates, equipment, terrain parks, consolidation of resorts, effects of the media) how do you envision the snow-sports education profession in the future? Particularly with children?

### **Application Deadline: January 31, 2016**

After initial application screening, selected applicants will be contacted for a phone or in person initial

interview. Applicants may be asked to participate in a brief behavioral survey.

Invitations to a second, 1-day, on-snow interview will be sent out February 28, 2016. This interview will validate skiing/riding and on-hill presentation skills. The hiring committee will determine the format. There is no fee for this one-day interview.

New CETT team members will need to do an audit of a CS1 and they will have a reverse audit the first time leading a CS1. CETT candidates are invited to do their CS1 audit before April 9<sup>th</sup>.
