



# **PSIA-Rocky Mountain-AASI Developing Teaching Skills**



**Discipline:** Alpine

**Time:** 2.5 hour sessions offered 4 times over 2 days

**Setting:** MSM / RMT / Resort Trainer Training – On-snow

## **Session Description:**

Designed for RM MSM / RMT / Resort Trainers, this session will focus on a practical understanding of the copy, chose, create model and the teaching expectations for instructors at certification levels 1, 2, & 3. Explore the teaching exam process at each level and practice developing hard and soft teaching skills.

## **Course Objectives:**

By the end of the session participants will:

- Ski a minimum of 5 runs. (Affective)
- Practice the presenting using the L1,2,3 teaching exam formats. (Psycho-motor)
- Identify areas of the L1,2,3 teaching scorecards that differentiate copy, choose, create teaching skill sets. (Cognitive)
- Present level specific activities that increase skill in the areas of building rapport & relevance, creating goal statements and logical progression building. (Cognitive)

## **Sample Activities:**

**9:00 – 11:30 or 1:00 – 3:30**

- Warm up run. Ask group “What differentiates teaching of less experienced instructors compared to more experienced instructors?”
- Identify 2 – 3 key components on the chair in groups of 4.
- In groups of 3, have participants give an L1, 2 & 3 teaching exam presentation.
- Ask group to discuss level expectations relative to rapport building, creating goals and presenting a logical progression of activities to meet the goal.
- Compare expectations with teaching scorecard.
