Job Title: Snowboard E1 Examiner

Job Summary: An E1 Examiner offers the highest quality education and service to our membership and member schools in support of our vision – “Provide the guest skier and riders at Rocky Mountain Region resorts the quality and consistency in the education they receive from our professional membership.”

Responsibilities:

- Provide educational experiences for our membership that align with PSIA-AASI’s Learning Connection Model.
- Use the PSIA-AASI Snowboard National Standards and support documents (Performance Guides, RM support documents, Scoring Criteria, etc.) to assess members’ performance at Level 1 assessments.
- Attend examiner meetings and collaborate with fellow staff before, during and after each event to ensure consistent experiences and assessments.
- Submit timely, thorough written candidate assessment forms after each event.
- Proactively communicate with RM admin to solve membership and/or event issues.
- Be a conduit between our stakeholders (membership, member schools, and official suppliers) and RM committees and leadership.
- Annually attend and complete all modules of Staff Training
- Actively manage availability and schedule to ensure the minimum work requirement of ten days is met each season.
- Communicate with the Event and Membership Coordinator about lodging or other travel needs.
- Actively read and respond to emails and phone calls from the RM office.
- Other duties as assigned.

Job Specifications

- \$220-\$275/day, plus food per diem and mileage/lodging when traveling away from home resort
- Part Time
- Must be willing to travel across our region to provide educational and assessment events.

Job Requirements:

- Snowboard Rocky Mountain Trainer or equivalent
- PSIA-AASI Children’s Specialist

- PSIA-AASI Freestyle Specialist 1 or greater
- Employed a minimum of 30 days per season for a PSIA-AASI Member School.
- Ski and Snowboard School Trainer Role is preferred.

Skills Required:

- Excellent communication and customer service skills.
- Strong interpersonal and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to multi-task and work independently without supervision.
- Basic computer skills - not limited to email, Google Docs, Word, Excel, Adobe, ProHub, and Unified Assessment Form portal.

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to ski, walk, kneel, crawl, carry, reach, stand, stoop, squat, and lift 35 pounds while actively teaching and coaching.
- Ability to ski, coach, provide feedback, and evaluate in an outdoor, high-altitude winter environment at all times.

Work Environment:

- This position will spend most of the time outside in a high-altitude, high-alpine, winter environment. Examiners wear ski equipment for the duration of their shift and are on their feet interacting with RM Membership most of the day.

Other Requirements:

- Must work a minimum of 10 days per season.
- Must provide own ski equipment, outerwear, and other necessary gear to work outside in an outdoor, high-altitude, winter environment.
