Setting: On-snow

Course Description:

- This clinic will be required once every four years if you are not involved in a certification pathway which may include pre courses, exams, ect. Please contact office for further questions or details
- The Goal is to help keep everyone on a similar page in terms of content, knowledge and understanding of certain concepts, theories and models that we all can use when teaching
- Opportunity for personal improvement in riding, teaching and movement analysis directly related to your level of certification

Prerequisite: AASI/PSIA membership, Level 2 or 3 Certified

Course Objectives:

- Keep up to date with the current riding, teaching and movement analysis standard of the certification you hold
- Learn what the exam process looks like today for the level of certification you currently hold
- Gain a deeper understanding of the current educational process
- Help you stay on top of your game to be a more effective instructor

Sample Activities:

- Ice breaker exercises to build rapport among the group and expose a variety of information useful for future exercises.
- Ride through current exam tasks
- Look at current Movement analysis test and practice using movement analysis skills

Materials Needed:

- Appropriate riding gear to be on snow both days
- Helmets are highly recommended
