Discipline: Snowboard

Time: 2 day Credits 2

Setting: On snow

**Course Description:** This 2 day clinic will focus on the education and human skills for creating a great guest centered lesson. We will explore the teaching and learning concepts such as learning styles, teaching styles, multiple intelligences, CAP model, and creative application to a variety of age groups and demographics. Learn to build effective progressions and organize successful lesson plans. Cultivate motivation and positive interaction with your guests while managing splits and class handling. This will be an interactive, participant driven clinic.

**Prerequisite:** AASI/PSIA membership, Snowboard Level 1 certified, comfortable on a variety of blue & blue/black terrain.

### Course Objectives:

- Participants will develop a practical understanding of teaching and learning concepts, how they fit into the lesson plan, and useful applications of each concept.
- Participants will strengthen their soft skills in learning to evaluate guests and make a connection, cultivate motivation and provide a guest-centered lesson
- Participants will come away with a variety of new and creative, fun approaches to introducing and practicing new skills.
- Participants will learn to build effective progressions, manage splits and class handling to keep lessons moving and successful

### Sample Activities:

1. Ice breaker exercises to build rapport among the group and expose a variety of information useful for future exercises.
2. Play and drills exploring learning and teaching styles
3. Focused teaching segments with peer feedback

### Materials Needed:

- Appropriate riding gear to be on snow both days
- Helmets are highly recommended
