The Snowboard Level 2 Preview Clinic is designed to introduce you to the Level 2 Certification standard and help you learn where to focus your training.

Snowboard Level 2 Certification is the second level of AASI certification, focused on intermediate snowboard instruction. At the Level 2, you're expected to demonstrate experience teaching intermediate level snowboarders, show a moderate level of knowledge of snowboard instruction concepts, and apply your knowledge and skill to situations on-snow and indoors.

Snowboard Level 2 MA Preview

Preview the Level 2 exam standards and movement analysis requirements as you prepare for certification. You will be given feedback where you currently stand in the national exam standard for movement analysis and the technical applications of teaching levels 5-7. You will gain a clearer picture of your ability to observe, describe and analyze board performance and body movements. Your Divisional Educator will recommend further training through additional clinics to aid in your development.

Snowboard Level 2 Ride Preview

Preview the Level 2 exam standards and exam riding task requirements as you prepare for your Level 2 Riding certification exam. You will be given feedback where you currently stand in the national exam standard for riding free-ride, freestyle, and specific tasks at levels 5-7. You will gain a clearer picture of the movements and skills that can be developed to move towards attaining the Level 2 riding standard. Your Divisional Educator will recommend further training through additional sessions to aid in your development.

Snowboard Level 2 Instruction Preview

Preview the Level 2 exam standards and exam teaching requirements as you prepare for your Level 2 Instruction certification exam. You will be given feedback where you currently stand in the national exam standard for teaching theory and practical application of technical teaching of levels 5-7.
