

# Telemark Level 2 Assessment Outline

## Course Description

Participants will demonstrate their technical understanding and personal performance while working through the skiing, teaching, and technical elements of the Level 2 Telemark Assessment. Participants are required to download and complete the Telemark Level 2/3 Certification Workbook from the PSIA-RM website prior to attending the assessment. By utilizing the certification checklist, participants will be able to enhance and monitor progress throughout the event.

Participants will earn a Level 2 Certification upon successfully meeting all performance requirements during the assessment. If you're not sure whether you're ready for Level 2 or 3 Certification, join us for the Tele Level 2/3 Prep Clinic first!

## Course Outcomes:

- Ski all intermediate-zone and easy advanced-zone terrain - see current Telemark National Certification Standards at [www.thesnowpros.org](http://www.thesnowpros.org)
- Competently teach Telemark skiing to students through the intermediate zone
- Describe basic movement patterns, and cause-and-effect relationships in skiers through the intermediate zone
- Define and interpret all terminology as described in the Telemark Technical Manual

## Sample Activities:

- Identify equipment needs for Telemark skiers in the Intermediate Zone
- Demonstrate short-radius linked Telemark turns in intermediate-zone bump terrain
- Demonstrate monomarks, 750 shuffles, and linked Telemark side slips
- Demonstrate how to apply the teaching model to meet the needs of the student
- Prescribe what a student should work on by prioritizing their skill needs from the intermediate zone to easy, advanced zones
- Understand the application of the Telemark fundamentals and skills in the Telemark maneuvers for a student from the intermediate zone to easy, advanced zones
