# **PSIA-AASI Alumni Membership Information**

### **Alumni Membership**

- Certified Members are eligible to move to the Alumni Membership Category if you have been a member for at least 6 years.
- The Alumni Membership Category is intended as a permanent status roughly equivalent to a "retired" member, or for those taking a break from teaching for a longer time period.
- Alumni Members are no longer considered Active Certified Members, but their historical certification(s) will show on their member card along with the date that certification expired.
- As an Alumni Member, you are **not required to take any educational events or earn any CEU credits**.
- An Alumni Member can choose to move back to Active status by completing the reinstatement process (see below).
- Alumni Members are welcome to attend educational events their previous certification level would have qualified them to attend at member prices and receive all correspondence and literature.
- Member benefits remain in place, although Alumni Members will not qualify for any Pro Deals from National PSIA-AASI suppliers if that supplier requires active certification as a qualifier for discounts.
- Alumni Members still earn yearly credit toward their anniversary pins.
- Alumni Member dues in the Rocky Mountain Region are \$82 for the First Chair Rate prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>, increasing to \$117 after July 1<sup>st</sup>. (vs. \$157 for active members First Chair rate, \$192 after July 1st).

# **Reinstatement Process**

## Same season, you must:

- Pay current season's full membership dues plus \$50 reactivation fee (less any amount already paid toward Alumni dues).
- Continue to meet CEU requirements (6 CEUs a season, plus any outstanding past and current CEUs up to a maximum of 24).
- This is a one-time opportunity. If you do not meet your CEU requirements you will be moved back to the Alumni membership category. If you want to reactivate your certification a second time, you must do your CEUs before your certification is restored and pay the current season's full membership dues plus \$105 reactivation fee (less any amount already paid toward Alumni dues).

### 1 – 4 Years in the Alumni Category, you must:

- Pay the current season's membership dues plus \$105 reactivation fee.
- Continue to meet CEU requirements (6 CEUs a season, plus any outstanding past and current CEUs up to a maximum of 24).

## 5 Years or More in the Alumni Category, you must:

- Pay the current season's membership dues plus \$190 reactivation fee.
- Continue to meet CEU requirements (6 CEUs a season, plus any outstanding past and current CEUs up to a maximum of 24).

#### 11 Years or More in the Alumni Category, you must:

Members may apply to a region for reinstatement consideration. If accepted, a
personal recertification plan will be developed by the region in which the member
wishes to recertify.

\*If going through the reinstatement process, the membership will show inactive status (including on the member card) until the required continuing education units (CEUs) are met, and any other reinstatement process requirements. Once completed membership status will update to active status.
