## Guidelines

### What we need:

### Label your memorabilia:

- Please IDENTIFY your memorabilia with as much detail as possible, such as:
  - o Name of people in photos, slides, film, videos etc. and name of the event
  - o Date of the photo/ video/ artifact
  - o Location of where photo/ video was taken
  - o Owner of artifact

- We will return ALL memorabilia to the address on your return mailer or S.A.S.E. If you do not include a return mailer or S.A.S.E. we will assume you do not want your memorabilia returned to you.
- We will take professional grade photos of items sent to us and email you a copy of the photo/s
