Alpine On-Snow Clinics:

All Levels TLC: This course will focus on the Technical portion of the Teaching Learning Connection (TLC). Attendees will spend 1 or 2 days on snow with qualified Rocky Mountain Ed staff. Attendees will understand how the Assessment Activities (ACs) evolve through Certification Levels 1, 2, and 3 and leave the clinic confident to address this portion of the TLC with pros at their home area.

RMT Workshop: *This course is for pros currently in the RMT Process (those who have passed the Entrance Exam). RMT candidates will spend 2 days on snow with qualified Rocky Mountain Ed staff. The focus will be on the Technical portion of the Teaching Learning Connection (TLC). Attendees will understand how the Assessment Activities (ACs) evolve through Certification Levels 1, 2, and 3 and leave the clinic confident to train pros at their home area.

Alpine Examiner 1 Development: *The 2020 E1 clinic is for current RMTs. It will focus on the Technical portion of the Teaching Learning Connection (TLC). If you are considering an application for the job as a Rocky Mountain Examiner, check out this 2-day clinic with qualified Ed Staff. We will use an IDP task and modify it to isolate and blend Skiing Fundamentals to help you understand the evolution of the Assessment Criteria from Level 1 to level 3 and leave the clinic confident to train pros at your home area. An update on the 2020 E1 hiring process will be available.

Supervisor Skills Workshop

Due to life in the COVID world the Supervisors Workshop transitioned into an online multi-session workshop. We have blown up the contents of the course and are in the process of piecing it back together into bite sized chunks and will offer this ongoing throughout the coming season. Snowboard On-Snow Clinics:

What's Up with Snowboard: This season's clinics will focus on adjustments made to our RM process designed to re-align our certification with what our instructors do on snow every day. This includes changes to Level 1 Teach, Ride, and Movement Analysis and tweaks to the L2 and L3 Teach and Movement Analysis days. We'll also discuss changes to the RMT process and preview the new RMT Preparation Workshops. This session is ideally suited to those who currently train new and returning instructors, and resort managers who would like a better understanding of how Snowboard Certification has evolved. Alpine participants are welcome.

Adaptive On-Snow Clinic

This clinic is intended for Adaptive Administrators, Managers, and Trainers who want to receive updated information on all levels of adaptive certification materials and processes; on-snow review of skiing tasks required for adaptive assessments; and information on how to train instructors for adaptive assessments.

We will also explore current online and on-snow educational opportunities, individual and small group mentoring, and Total Training Program opportunities.

Valuable discussion about providing adaptive snowsports lessons and instructor training in the Covid era will occur with information coming from the group leader and participants.

Children's Multi Discipline Clinic

CS1/CS2 Update and Refresh- This clinic will include: Process Updates, Clarification of Standards, Understanding and Utilizing Assessment Tools, Candidate Performance Trends and Soft Skill Training Tactics. This clinic is for any MSM attendee who will be training instructors to prepare for either CS1 or CS2 this winter. In the Covid environment we've adjusted our processes for the CS1 and CS2.
