<u>**Rocky Mountain *TOTAL* Training Pass **</u> <u>Policies & Procedures</u>

The purpose of the Total training Pass (TTP) is to bring the latest information and developments in modern snowsports teaching techniques to your resort and to prepare potential certification candidates for exams through direct, meaningful and consistent contact with a PSIA-RM-AASI examiner. It is our goal to assign the best staff member to meet your individual training needs.

The TTP costs \$8000 for 20 sessions, \$7200 for 16 sessions, \$5000 for 10 sessions or \$3300 for 6 days with the clinic leader (There are <u>scholarships</u> available in varying dollar amounts that can defer some of the cost of the TTP at \$200 per day with a maximum of \$2000 awarded per school). Ideally each TTP purchased would be for one discipline, however multiple TTP's can be purchased for multiple disciplines and the 10 days can be split up. Requests for the TTP need to be in the RM office no later than October 26th, 2018 for the 18/19 season. Payments for the TTP need to be in the RM office no later than November 23, 2018 for the 18/19 season. To ensure the success and financial viability of the TTP program, please let us know if there are any comps/discounts that you can provide the TTP staff when it comes to lodging, food, etc.

It is the ski school's responsibility to provide/understand the following items for TTP Staff. Please use this as a check list:

- Meeting place or meeting room must be arranged and paid for by requesting school
- AV equipment (TV, VCR, Laptop, computer, screen, projector) must be supplied if needed
- Notification/confirmation notices to participants WILL NOT be sent out by PSIA-RM all details are to be verified and sent to participants by the requesting school
- Submit required TTP application and scholarship form by October 26, 2018
- Lift Ticket for TTP staff
- No refunds or rain checks will be issued for days unused
- No clinic credits will be issued for TTP events
- TTP cannot be used to host any exam or current PSIA-RM-AASI course
- TTP can only be requested and paid for by a Snowsports Director/Manager
- TTP Scholarships can only be requested by a Snowsports Director/Manager
